What is Ewing’s Sarcoma?

Ewing’s sarcoma is a rare form of bone cancer that strikes children and adolescents. It is one in a group of four related cancers, known collectively as the Ewing’s family of tumors (EFT).

Only about 300 cases occur every year in the U.S. As a consequence, diagnosis is often delayed, and research efforts are underfunded.

Despite its status as a rare cancer, Ewing’s sarcoma currently affects several Quad City area children and young adults.

The Nick Teddy Foundation was established in 2012 in loving memory of Nicholas Theodore Strub, who died of complications of Ewing’s sarcoma on November 22, 2011.

Nick was diagnosed with Ewing’s sarcoma in September of 2006, and spent more than five years fighting his battle. Nick never let his disease get in the way of his passion for life. He had the warmest smile, the kindest heart, and a great sense of humor.

Nick’s life, as well as so many others with Ewing’s sarcoma, was cut far too short, But his legacy lives on through the lives he touched.

It is the Nick Teddy Foundation’s mission to carry forward Nick’s legacy, by raising money for research, and helping others who are affected by this disease.
